Solid Waste Policy

Per Skagit County Department of Health, every septic system is required to have an inspection every 1 or 3 years (depending on the type of septic system), and recorded with the Skagit County Dept of Health. This is legally required by Skagit County. ([WAC 246-272A-0270](#)). ** See the DOCUMENTS page of the CapeHornMaintCo website for a link to the Skagit County Dept of Health page for more information.

As stated in the By-Laws you are required to have on file with the office a record of how you are disposing of solid waste. If you have a septic, proof that it has been inspected per Skagit County requirements is required by either a receipt of inspection or a record from Skagit County Health Dept. Any other method of solid waste disposal, including a waste holding tank, inside or outside of your RV, or a porta-potty, would require a receipt of where you are dumping it or a receipt for having it pumped.

Please make sure the office has this information.

This requirement is for the health and safety of all residents in Cape Horn.
